ABOUT THE PROGRAM

This program is authorized by 34 U.S.C. § 20125. Congress created the Grants to Reduce Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, Sexual Assault, and Stalking on Campus Program in recognition of the unique issues and challenges that colleges and universities face in preventing and responding to domestic violence, dating violence, dating violence, and stalking. The Campus Program encourages a comprehensive coordinated community approach that enhances victim safety, provides services for victims, and supports efforts to hold offenders accountable. The funding supports activities that develop and strengthen trauma informed victim services and strategies to prevent, investigate, and respond to domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking on campus.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY:

Eligible applicants are limited to: Institutions of higher education in the United States and U.S. territories including: **Historically Black Colleges and Universities, Tribal Colleges and Universities, Hispanic Serving Institutions, and other Minority Serving Institutions.**

The grant project period is **36 months.**
Project award amounts are up to **\$400,000.**
